


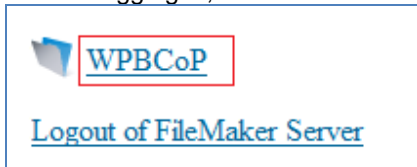
1. Click to open the WPBCoP database webpage:

2. When the webpage shows as below:





In the User Name column, type in "WPBCoPGuest" with the exact upper and lower case; leave the Password column blank. Then click on the Login button.



3. After logging in, click on the WPBCoP database link:





Now you can see the record/document information.

4. Guest users have browsing and searching access to the database.

For browsing through the records, you can use the browse button  to go to previous/next record in default order, or you can type in the sequence number of a specific record here  and click the "Go to record" button to jump to that record directly.

5. For the search function, click  to get into Find Mode. Now you can type in your search criteria in each field and/or choose from the dropdown lists. After putting in all your search criteria, click the "Perform Find" button .

Now all records/documents that meet your criteria will be selected, and you can use the browse button  to look through these records.

6. To go back to the browsing interface, click on the Browse Mode .

7. While browsing, citation information is shown at the Document Type section:

The tabbed panel always shows the previously viewed tab by default. So when you see a record/document that you are interested in, you might need to manually click the tab in accordance to its document type as indicated in the field above the panel. Such as the example shown in the above picture, the record's Document Type is "Article" and its detailed information is given in the "Article" tab.
